



TRADITIONAL PILSNER

UNDER-MODIFIED MALT

ANALYSIS

Moisture (%)	≤5
Color (°L)	1,4 / 1,8
Fine Grind Extract	≥81
F/C	≤3,5
Mash (min)	15-25

DESCRIPTION

Our Traditional Pilsner is a lightly under-modified malt developed specifically for decoction mashing.

NOTES

Ideally boiled for 90 minutes when used at 100% of the grist. It is also commonly used at up to 20% to enhance body and foam retention. Monitor wort viscosity carefully.

SUBSTITUTIONS

Traditional under-modified Pilsner malts.

APPLICATIONS

Provides an excellent base for both lager and ale styles requiring exceptional drinkability. Particularly suited for pilsners, lagers, Kölsch, and other delicate styles where malt purity is essential.

PROPERTIES

- Clean, neutral malt profile that allows hop character to shine
- Contributes lightness and exceptional drinkability
- Good enzymatic activity, allowing the inclusion of specialty malts
- Promotes stable foam and a dry finish



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PRECAUTIONS

- Risk of DMS formation — a vigorous boil is recommended (≥ 60 –90 minutes)
- Monitor ventilation and evaporation during the boil
- May present a risk of stuck mash at higher inclusion rates ($> 40\%$), depending on the grist composition and milling
- Adjust milling settings and lauter bed management as needed to maintain proper filtration efficiency.
